2. AT LEAST two from the following COMM Core courses: COMM 2500, 2200 and 2300 (formerly COMM 3100, 3200, 3300, respectively)
3. Only one APPLIED course (3 credits) can be used from the following list: COMM 2100, 2110, 2700 (formerly 2940), 3520 (formerly 4800), 3530 (formerly 4820), 3798 (formerly 4940), 4981 (formerly 4991), and 4982 (formerly 4992).
4. COMM 4995 and 4998 cannot be used without the permission of your Communication Advisor.
5. A final copy of this Plan of Study must be filed with the Registrar's office during the first four weeks of the semester in which you plan to graduate.
